## **Profile – Mark Duntemann**

**Mark Duntemann** is the owner of Duntemann Urban Forestry. He is an internationally recognized expert in tree risk assessment and tree risk management policy development. Mark has served as an expert witness in over fifty tree-related injury and fatality cases. This work informs his presentations.

Mark has a Master's degree in Urban Forestry from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He is an International Society of Arboriculture (ISA) Board-Certified Master Arborist. Mark has acquired his ISA tree risk assessment qualification (TRAQ), and the UK-based Arboriculture Association's tree assessment certification. Mark is the ISA representative to the seven-member Council of Tree and Landscape Appraisers. The CTLA is currently tasked with developing the 10<sup>th</sup> edition of the Plant Appraisal Guide.

Mark is currently developing a book on tree risk management and recently completed a post-graduate certificate in risk management from Harvard's Chan School of Public Health. His expertise in urban forestry management informs his program review and policy development role for municipal, State, and Federal agencies. He is currently advising New York City Parks and the City of Hong Kong. Mark is also keenly interested in the cultural connection trees provide to the community and has worked on numerous heritage tree preservation projects.
